CAMPO HOSTING PUBLIC MEETINGS TO GATHER INPUT ON 2045 REGIONAL ARTERIALS PLAN

March 29, 2018

Austin, Texas – The Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) will host eleven public open house meetings to share background information and collect input on CAMPO’s 2045 Regional Arterials Plan (RAP).

CAMPO is developing a Regional Arterials Plan (RAP) to provide mobility choices that are safe, convenient, reliable, and efficient. Arterials are roads that connect to freeways, local streets, and destinations. In areas without major highways, arterials connect communities and provide for longer distance travel. In areas with major highways, arterials can be used for short trips which frees up traffic on the major highways meant for long distance travel. Examples of arterials in the CAMPO region include Parmer Lane, SH 21, and FM 969. The Regional Arterials Plan will focus on roads that serve as major corridors and play a vital role in connecting people and places.

Public input and comments are an important part of the planning process. Community members are encouraged to attend an open house and complete a survey. All open houses are a come and go format; no presentation will be given. Open houses will be held 4 – 7 p.m., unless otherwise noted, and kids activities will be available.
