CAMPO HOSTING OPEN HOUSE MEETINGS TO GATHER FEEDBACK ON \$400 MILLION TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

March 28, 2018

Austin, Texas – The Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) will be hosting open house meetings to share information and collect public input on CAMPO’s 2019–2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This TIP includes about \$400 million of new multimodal transportation funding for the six-county CAMPO region over the four-year cycle.

“This is the largest funding allocation CAMPO has ever received and I’m excited about this big step in Central Texas communities being able to provide a safer, more mobile transportation system. The CAMPO Board adopted a new process to ensure project selection is thorough, fair, and transparent, not only for this TIP, but also for future funding decisions,” said Will Conley, CAMPO Transportation Policy Board chair.

The recommended projects include over 50 projects spread over road, transit, biking and walking, and road operations categories. Additionally, six studies are recommended to receive funding.

“CAMPO’s funding is a force-multiplier enabling local governments to offer you more options on mobility no matter how you choose to get around town,” said Austin Mayor and CAMPO Transportation Policy Board vice-chair Steve Adler.

A list of recommended projects and maps will be available for public review and comment at six open house meetings. All open houses are a come and go format; no presentation will be given. Open houses will be held 4 – 7 p.m. and kids activities will be available.

An online open house and commenting will be available April 2 – 30, 2018 at www.campotexas.org/current-outreach-opportunities/. The public comment period closes at 5 p.m. April 30, 2018.

The CAMPO Transportation Policy Board (TPB) will consider public comment, review, and act on funding projects for the 2019–2022 TIP at their May 7, 2018. When adopting the new TIP, the TPB can approve the entire recommended project list or add and remove projects from the list.
